Eden's brand new online Sustainable Early Leadership Professional Development Programme is designed to bring early-career teachers towards a school leadership role to sustain their school community, themselves and the planet. Through an immersive online programme over two terms participants will gain clarity over purpose, explore uncertainty and complexity, and understand their personal agency in a rapidly changing world.

# Eden Project Changemakers Course Programme 2021

Session	Theme
1. 27 <sup>th</sup> January	<b>The need for Change</b> Understanding our changing world and the need for change. You will leave this session with a clearer understanding of the role of schools and teachers in shaping a positive future together with our learners.
2. 17 <sup>th</sup> March	<b>Proven models for Change</b> On the very day we celebrate Eden's 20 <sup>th</sup> birthday, we will look back at our impact, and forward to the future with Eden's co-founder Sir Tim Smit. You will leave with a toolkit of models for understanding sustainability, and for thinking about leading and managing change.
3. 21 <sup>st</sup> April	<b>Grab the Change</b> This session takes inspiration from education and environmental innovators around the world, including David Price, author of <i>The Power of Us</i> . Supported by group coaching, you begin to identify opportunities for, and obstacles to, sustainable change for yourself and your school.
4. 30 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>You are a Changemaker!</b> Aligning values, purpose and practice, you will leave ready to apply all that you've learned, supported by your network of Eden Changemakers.
