- Choosing and using VLE platforms and associated EdTech software for teaching, communication and feedback, including Google Classroom, Seesaw, Class Dojo, Tapestry, Wonde Single Sign On, Screencastify, Book Creator.
- Understanding how to deploy and manage specific curriculum-based EdTech systems that children love to use and teachers can work with remotely.
- Safeguarding considerations and options for SEND education.
- Strategies for MATs & schools for communicating to families clearly; creating and maintaining presence through use of video, social media and web-sites.
- Utilising a school's MIS to keep parents informed and distribute information effectively. Integrating your MIS data with other school EdTech systems.
- Strategies for organising and running internal staff communications; management of documents and workflow processes. Particular emphasis on use of Microsoft 365 / Teams / SharePoint.
- Guidance on procurement and setup of equipment including back-to-school circumstances; distributing devices to children; utilising single sign-on technologies; specific and informed hardware choices.

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
