'All children belong in school'

Low attendance is identified as an area for improvement in all phases in Cornwall. These programmes support a countywide strategy to improve belonging and attendance in schools. Using a rigorous assessment of need, this programme will support leaders and teachers to plan, implement and evaluate an evidence - informed approach, ensuring all pupils thrive in school. Whilst some elements of the programme are cross phase, 3 days are age/phase specific, focusing on things that schools can influence.

All children belong in schools and colleges – Secondary & Post 16

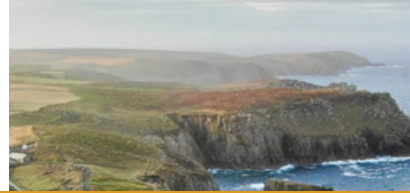
Day One – 6th December 2023, Day Two – 1st March 2024
