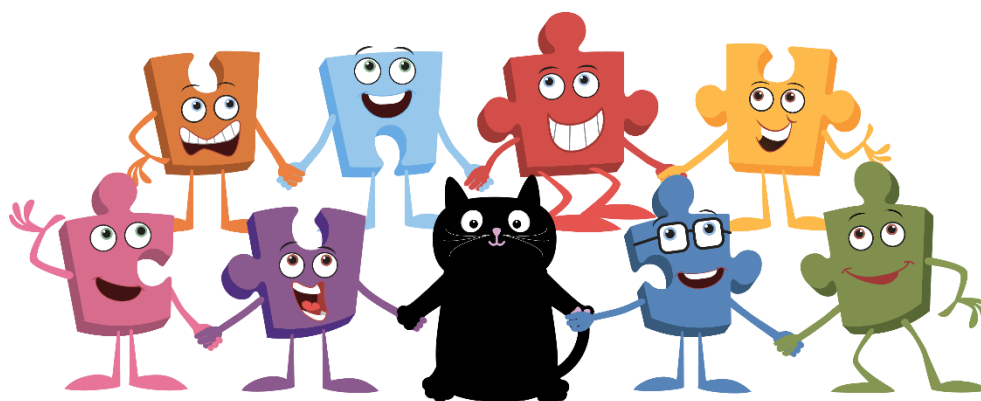
Jigsaw PSHE 3-11 – What’s new?

We have been continuing to review all our materials to make sure that they continue to be relevant and useful. We are careful not to make any substantial changes that may have an impact on any adaptations you may have made, so you can see all the main changes in the [Updates](#) section of the website.

We are often asked about our content related to digital literacy. We know that children of all ages are now using digital devices, and you will find that Jigsaw builds in teaching and learning opportunities around digital safety and online relationships as an extension about learning about safety and relationships across all aspects of our lives. You will notice that small changes are made throughout all the materials to reflect online experiences that children may have now, and to help prepare them for the future. In the Relationships Puzzle for Year 5, there is still the more focussed content on online relationships, but you will notice that there are small tweaks and extensions to scenarios to reflect current trends and language related to being online.

Our series of short webinars on RSHE are now on the portal, and you can use these to help you plan and prepare for teaching Relationships and Changing Me, and we have new webinars in May on Oracy and Bereavement that ALL schools can register for.

Jigsaw RE – What's new?

Jigsaw RE launched in September 2023, providing a comprehensive programme of enquiries to support schools in delivering high-quality RE. Each enquiry is fully resourced with slides, activities, worksheets and more.

With over 80 enquiries across a range of worldviews, Jigsaw RE can be adapted to meet the needs of each agreed syllabus, as well as each schools individual context and cohort. In each key stage we currently provide: 6+ Christianity enquiries, 3 enquiries for the major religions (Buddhism, Islam, Judaism, Sanatana Dharma (Hindu) and Sikhi) and 1 enquiry for Humanism. This is an ever-growing offering, with Baha'i units soon to be released and Ethical Veganism in development.

As well as these resources, the Jigsaw RE team are constantly working to provide up-to-date and high-quality CPD. Our ongoing free webinars are open to all schools and cover a range of topics.

Our team of regional advisors have been delivering successful training in RE networks and conferences across the country, including a 'Diversity and Unconscious Bias' session.
