

Vacancy – NPQ course facilitators for Cornwall

Cornwall Teaching Schools are collaborating with the Devon Teaching School Partnership to offer NPQSL and NPQML training in Cornwall from September 2019. Would you like to become one of the programme facilitators for Cornwall? This will involve working alongside existing facilitators (currently running the same courses in Devon) who will be running the first round of courses for the Cornwall Teaching Schools Together in Cornwall starting in October 2019. You will then take the lead in running the courses for Cornwall.



National Professional Qualification in Senior Leadership NPQSL

A successful course for aspiring senior leaders with cross-school responsibilities, This could include experienced middle leaders, deputy heads, SENDCOs, subject leads working across MATs. Participants will receive two coaching sessions. They will also have the opportunity to visit and review another school.

National Professional Qualification in Middle Leadership NPQML

This successful programme is for middle leaders who currently lead a small team within their school. In addition to the NPQML curriculum the programme will support middle leaders in their own schools with a targeted coaching offer.

Delivery of the courses involves 3 face to face sessions and one twilight over the year as well as 1:1 coaching in participants' schools to develop personal leadership at the beginning and end of their programme. Facilitators will be

supported by a Lead facilitator experienced in delivering NPQ programmes and who will jointly deliver at each of the face to face events.

Training materials will be provided but adapted through the year to meet the needs of the cohort. Additional planning time will be given to support facilitators to prepare. The total time across the year depending on the size of the cohort will be 10-12 days.
