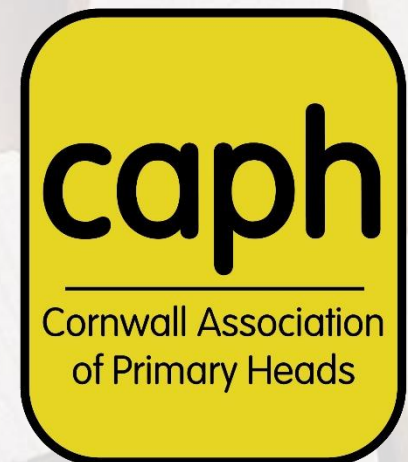

GDPR Seminars



In partnership with Michelmores, we are hosting seminars on the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016 (GDPR), **which comes into force on 25 May 2018**. The sessions will be delivered by [Russell Holland, Barrister](#) in Michelmores Education Team.

The GDPR will be the biggest reform of data protection and privacy law in over two decades. It replaces the existing Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA), adding a number of key responsibilities and requirements. Like the DPA, the GDPR will apply to schools and academies.

Running a Primary or Secondary School

A series of tailor made training days designed to further develop leadership and management skills

These practical training days are intended for those aspiring to 'Run a School'; about to take up a leadership role in a school and those currently engaged in the business of 'Running a School'.

Overview

One in ten children and young people aged 5 to 16 has a clinically diagnosed mental health disorder and around one in seven has less severe problems. Our youth spend more time in school than they do anywhere else except their own home. School is one of the best places for both educators and students to become increasingly aware of mental health, mental health problems and mental health disorders. However it is an area that schools naturally find a challenge to manage and support.

In this Masterclass, Natasha will share approaches to supporting children with poor mental health, promote positive mental health and identify and address those with less severe problems at an early stage and build their resilience.

Natasha Devon MBE is a Writer, Campaigner and Pundit. She is co-founder of the Self Esteem Team & the Body Gossip Education Programme, both working in schools to help teenagers, their parents and teachers with mental health & body image challenges. Communicating with young fathers and encouraging them to be involved in the lives of their children and families is widely recognised as being highly important throughout medical, social care and youth work organisations. However many practitioners may feel daunted by the prospect of working with young men in a fathering role, whilst others may consider them to be a group that is almost impossible to engage with. Similarly many of these young men often describe how they feel invisible or peripheral; ignored or misunderstood by many professionals and services.
