Our Approach

Our Skills for Life programmes primarily support children and young people who face challenges in engaging in full-time mainstream education and need some additional interventions to fulfil their potential. In 2022/23 we worked with 1115 children, young people (and some adults) through our Skills for Life programmes at our site near Penryn.

Most of the children and young people we support have a range of complex needs, often exacerbated by poverty. Some have experienced significant trauma through abuse, others have disabilities that make it difficult for them to understand the complexities of society and many have significant mental health concerns that prevent them from fully engaging with their education setting, families and peers. Many of these children and young people struggle to regulate their emotions and this can manifest in presenting behaviours that can challenge, making it difficult for mainstream education settings to meet their needs alongside the needs of the whole class.


We work with schools, social workers, parent/carers, and the young person, to develop a programme that encourages the young person to understand themselves better and to develop coping strategies that enable them to participate more fully in mainstream education. We empower them to share their learning with their keyworkers.

Costs:

1 session, 1 pupil (within a group): £200 per session 1 session for up to 6 pupils: £800 per session 6 sessions, 6 pupils: £750 per session 12 sessions, 6 pupils: £700 per session (£116 per person per session)

The level of skill in trauma informed practice is outstanding. We have experienced 3 instructors and all, although different, have shown superb understanding and application of trauma informed practice. Our regular instructor has highly skilled communication, never wavers, is kind, encouraging, gentle but firm with the boundaries and full of fun to match the young person. The activities on offer are excellent, although we have only accessed a few so far. Our instructor is able to make an activity out of anything, she is imaginative and creative, able to encourage child led learning.
