







Primary Schools: Want to take part in an exciting research study looking at a teacher classroom management course?

Researchers at the University of Exeter are running a research study testing the impact of a classroom management programme on children's mental health, behaviour and academic attainment.



Who can take part?

We are looking for primary schools who have Year 1 and Year 2 teachers willing to travel for 6 days of training to either Bristol, Cornwall, Dorset, Liverpool or Southampton to take part.

What's involved?

- Working with 140 primary schools.
- Half of schools randomised to receive training, half to act as controls.
- Following current reception children for two years.
- Teachers involved complete brief questionnaires on children's behaviour in summer terms of 2019, 2020 and 2021.
- We will ask schools to provide raw maths SATS scores.
- Schools receive £400 for each Year 1 and Year 2 teacher they have to support testing burden.
