This course is about you – you as a leader, your strengths, potential and the plans you have for your career and your life.



In this programme you will have:

Time for self-evaluation and guided reflection

- **Time** to consider the face of senior leadership and headship
- **Time** to reflect upon different scenarios
- **Time** with experienced female senior leaders to mentor and guide

In addition to the training days, you will have the chance to visit schools with female heads. You will have time to observe, discuss and reflect.

The course will be:

- **Practical** – looking at what is required to be a successful senior leader
- **Balanced** – acknowledging work, life and many conflicting demands
